Harald Aadland is concertmaster of the Norwegian Radio Orchestra and is professor at the Music Academy in Oslo. He was the first violinist in The Norwegian String Quartet for ten years. The quartet won first prize in the Mozart Competition in Brussels and toured extensively in Russia , U.S.A, and Europe. As an active chamber musician Aadland has performed in the Festivals in Bath, Schleswig-Holstein , Bergen Festival , Risør, Prussia Cove . As a soloist he has performed regularly with The radio Orchestra in Oslo . Some of the works he has performed are; Schumann concerto, Tippet Double with Andrew Manze conducting , Schnittke Moz-art and Concertone by Mozart with his wife Eileen Siegel and Paavo Jarvi conducting. . He has several recordings with The Norwegian String Quartet including a recording of Grieg quartet that Gramophone Magazine gave highest acclaim. He has also recorded several solo works with The Norwegian Radio Orchestra. He has commissioned and performed a violin concerto by Knut Vaage and will record this work in the fall of 2018
